### Parking Information

Wingra School's building is home to our school as well as New Morning Nursery School. We also provide space for Dudgeon-Monroe Neighborhood Association meetings and City of Madison elections. Given the amount of people coming and going each day, finding adequate parking can be difficult. For the safety of all, we have the following parking guidelines and reminders. Please review these, and sign below.

- We encourage families to carpool to school, if and when possible.
- Please follow all parking signs, regulations, and laws, including respecting our neighbors' driveways and avoiding the "no parking" zone heading up the hill on Western Avenue. Madison Police issue tickets to cars parked there.
- Please do not use the Wingra parking lot for picking up and dropping off students, unless you are authorized to use the handicap space. This applies to parents of children who attend both Wingra School and New Morning, Monday through Friday, in all weather, and even if children are not visibly present.
- Please inform relatives, friends, and others who transport your child of these safety rules.

### Transportation Reimbursement

*Students who qualify for transportation in the Madison Metropolitan School District area must meet the following eligibility requirements: Reside within the boundaries of MMMSD; Reside within the boundaries of the school attendance area; Be five years old by September 1, 2019; Be in fifth grade or younger; Reside more than 1.5 miles from Wingra School.*

*If a family resides within the boundaries of other school districts like Middleton, Monona, Oregon, or Verona/Fitchburg, the requirements for transportation reimbursement are similar to Madison's with the exception that they reimburse parents of children that are in Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.*
